Noted St. Thomas author, poet and artist Gail McNaughton has launched a book that draws upon her spirituality, and furthers her quest to bring healing to the world.

Called Angel Witness, McNaughton had the book published earlier this year through Xlibris, a U.S. based publishing company.

She explained it's a book filled with her inspirational poetry, prose, doodle art and photographs, all inspired by angels or connected in some way to those divine beings.

The book will appeal to people who are involved with angels, already enjoy spirituality and people in the community who have enjoyed what Gail has written in the past.

McNaughton noted the community has yet to recover from the May, 2008 fire that destroyed Alma College. She hopes Angel Witness and her other creative efforts go a long way toward bringing that healing power to the community.

"This is a book of encouragement for people, that anybody can write a book. You find your favourite subject matter and just plug away at it every day. If I can do it, other people can too and all of a sudden it becomes a part of you."

Gail explained she became interested in angels, and drawn to spirituality in 1994 when her cat, RW, died. She says she had an angelic experience and since then, has written with spiritual themes in mind - particularly her doodle art, which features a lot of angels.

"Jumbo was painted pink in 2001 and he became magical and can travel around ... in the postcard, Jumbo is visiting the IPM," she explained.

All three projects are being undertaken out-ofpocket by the McNaughtons - they're donating the fruits of their labours to the plowing match.

"It's worth well over

\$10,000," Bob said. "For us it's a once-in-a-lifetime thing."

It's all part of the Dog and Pony Productions philosophy which helps businesses to advertise and promote their products and services.
